

SOUTHERY PARISH

Purpose of the Annual Parish Meeting - The main purpose is to enable the registered electors to discuss parish affairs. This meeting is also an opportunity for the Council and community group leaders to update the community about their activities over the last year and outline plans for the future.

Who can attend the meeting? - Anyone may attend but only registered electors in the parish of Southery may vote.

Who will chair the meeting? – The Chairman of the Parish Council must chair the meeting, if present. In his absence, the vice chairman must preside if present. If neither is able to attend, then the meeting will elect a chairman from those electors present.

Will notes be taken of the meeting? - Yes, a written record of the meeting will be taken. The rules on the signature and admissibility of minutes are the same as those for Parish Council meetings.
